



## 2018 COLLEGE SPORT WELLINGTON BOWLS

### PLAYING CONDITIONS

#### 1. DAY-DATES

Play is on Thursdays commencing 15 February with finals 29 March.  
Schools will be invited to re-enter junior teams for competition in Term 4

#### 2. VENUES

Team will play at Bowling Clubs within their zones as identified on the draw

#### 3. START TIME

Play is scheduled to start at 4.00pm

#### 4. TEAM COMPOSITION & SUPERVISION

- [i] It is a requirement that there be an adult supervisor for each school.
- [ii] Teams are to consist of three players (boys, girls or mixed). A minimum of 2 players required.
- [iii] A team may be selected from a squad but where a school has more than one team; players may only play for one team & not be interchanged.

#### 5. FORMAT

Shall be two bowl triples for a time limit of 50 minutes. If 2 players they play 3 bowls each. The end being played at this point shall be completed. If at this stage the match is drawn, that shall be the final score.

#### 6. DRESS AND EQUIPMENT

- [i] Players must wear some form of appropriate uniform – school sports top/tracksuit bottom or equivalent. It is not acceptable to wear school day uniform.
- [ii] Players must wear flat-soled shoes that will not damage the greens. Trainers will be generally acceptable. NO JANDALS
- [iii] Players are responsible for providing their own bowls. Club co-ordinators will generally be able to arrange the loan of club bowls
- [iv] The Club co-ordinator of the club hosting the round is responsible for arranging club provided equipment (mats, jacks and score boards) and for a suitable timekeeping system.

#### 7. DEFAULTS AND CANCELLATIONS

These must be advised by 12.00noon on the day of play to:

- **The opposing school**
- **College Sport**
- **The Bowling Club scheduled to host the game.**

**8. RESULTS**

Club co-ordinators of the Club where the games are played are responsible for advising College Sport Wellington of the results within one day of the game.

**9. POINTS**

Games will be scored as 3 points for a win, 2 for a draw and 1 point for a loss by 3 or less.

**10. REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS**

The CSW Championships will be held on Tuesday 13 March at a venue to be confirmed. Bowlers have a choice of playing singles or pairs... not both.

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
