- Report time for all players is 8.45am
- Cancellations will be communicated on the morning of event
- As this is a Regional Championship only recognised tennis players from your school should be entered but there is no limit to entries
- If balloting out is required the top 24 players from the configure ranking list will be selected to play
- When completing the entry, please check with students any Configure ranking they have and identify it. This assists with seedings
- Players may enter singles or doubles, **but not both.**
- Entry fee is \$5 per player-schools will be invoiced
- On line entries close 5 March

RULES:

- Matches will be the best of 2 short sets (short sets are the first to 4 games with a tiebreaker to 7 at 4-4). If sets are tied at 1 all a tiebreaker to 10 is then played to determine the winner.
- Finals will be the best of 3 short sets – “Short sets to 4 with conventional Tie Break (to 7) at 4 games all”.
However, match length may be altered by tournament organisers should circumstances deem it necessary.
- Short Deuces
- Winners must advise results immediately to Tournament Control
- Return Balls to Tournament control
- Players to Umpire own games
- A plate event will be run for each competition (weather permitting)
- Players are guaranteed two games (weather permitting)
